- You are being forced to work.
- You are being forced to work in a house as a domestic worker without any rest.
- You are being forced to prostitute yourself or take part in pornography.
- You are being forced to marry someone you do not wish to marry.
- You are being forced to beg on the street.
- You are being forced to commit crime.
