We have worked on a new cleaning and waste collection contract, which, from March, will involve more staff and new electric vehicles that will reduce emissions and noise, among other improvements. With the new contract we adapt to each

neighbourhood's needs every moment and improve the channels through which residents can report incidents. Because only with everyone's involvement and co-responsibility can we take care of our city.

We take care of Barcelona. A city that takes pride in its inhabitants and enchants everyone who visits it. We will all have a cleaner and more sustainable city. A Barcelona to live in.

Cleaning up

More resources in intensive use areas, green areas and squares

New fast response service

New continuous care service for public spaces



At Sant Martí de Provençals

We increased street and squares from 1 to 3 days a week

We increased green areas cleaning from 2 to 7 days a week by incorporating special work centres in the neighbourhood

We incorporated modified sweepers on bike lanes

We increased exterior and interior washing of containers to prevent bad smells

A total of 26 people and 11 cleaning vehicles are serving the neighborhood

Waste

More frequency, fewer emissions and noise

More selective collection containers

More public space and better accessibility



At Sant Martí de Provençals

We included recollection of all kinds of plastics and metals, which from now on, can be deposited in yellow bins

We incorporated a new bulk collection system with electric vehicles

We duplicated the interior and exterior cleaning of the containers in the high season

We placed 393 new containers and redistributed them to free up public space
