



Lawyer and artist



Who is Christy White?

How would you describe your experience within the Black community in Barcelona?



What does Christy enjoy doing in her free time?

I love to write. It's a good way to express emotions. For a long time, I wrote a lot about suffering and anger, which reflected my childhood. But now it's different. My writing has changed a lot because I have had many more experiences. Now I write about healing, transformation and love.

Ali Parsa

Entrepreneur



Who is Ali Parsa?

I'm Ali Parsa. I was born in Tehran. I moved to Barcelona from London (United Kingdom) and I am the CEO of Quadrivia Al. I am a serial entrepreneur in the healthcare sector. I previously worked as a financial agent for Goldman Sachs in London and New York, and later became a tech entrepreneur in Silicon Valley and London. I moved to Barcelona to secure funding for my new company.

What was your first impression of Barcelona?

My first impression of the city was: "This is a city close to the sea and the mountains, with great food and culture, and beautiful, friendly people". I loved it from the moment I arrived. It has been very easy to come and settle here. Barcelona is a very easy city to move to, settle in, live in and start working immediately.

Do you have any hobbies or passions?

I like sports and cooking. I can walk along the seafront, swim, go hiking, cycle in the mountains, and visit markets to buy the best ingredients for cooking. I love being here. I would describe Barcelona as a place with great cultural diversity. You also find it in the food and the sea. And the same goes for the diversity of people who have made Barcelona their home.

Shilpa Arora

Data scientist



Who is Shilpa?

I'm Shilpa Arora, I'm 33 years old, I'm from India and I moved to Barcelona about two years ago. I started working with Giga, a UNICEF and ITU initiative to connect schools to the internet. At first, I worked remotely from India, and then I came here when the office was established, which has become Giga's tech hub in Barcelona. So, when the timing was right, I moved here, and I loved how easy it is to walk around the city and how friendly everyone is.

Tell us something you particularly enjoy about living in Barcelona.

I like eating lots of lentils and grains, rather than focusing entirely on meat products. I enjoy living in Barcelona because there are many shops where you can buy high-quality organic vegetables. I usually go and buy local fruits and vegetables, as well as visit speciality stores for legumes and cereals, where I can buy different types of lentils and beans, and grains like quinoa, bulgur, and basmati rice. I buy these and try to cook at home, which allows me to maintain a healthy and balanced diet.

Who is Yoshi?

My name is Yoshi Sislay and I was born in Osaka, Japan. I'm an illustrator and have travelled to various places like Chicago, USA, London, and New Zealand. I've been living in Barcelona for 20 years.

What is Yoshi's passion?

My passion is drawing. When I talk about my work, all my friends say, "Don't talk about work, we just want to enjoy ourselves, but I enjoy my work, so I like talking about it".

What do you enjoy doing in your free time?

What I like most, apart from work, is going to the beach or the mountains and enjoying nature. There are a lot of parks in Barcelona, such as Ciutadella, Parc de l'Estació del Nord and Jardins de les Tres Xemeneies. Since I have two children, I enjoy spending time with them walking, drawing, watching TV together, playing video games, or playing football. Oh, and I also really enjoy going out for a glass of cava and Catalan cuisine in general.

Who is Fernanda?
