





# Frequently asked questions

#### What kind of support will I receive as a CaixaBank volunteer?

I You can always rely on your local Volunteer Technical Office to guide you through your first activities and answer any questions you may have as a CaixaBankvolunteer.

#### As a volunteer, am I covered by any insurance?

I Yes. Like all CaixaBank volunteers, you are covered by a collective accident and liability insurance policy for any damage or injury that may occur while volunteering.

### Can I participate in a volunteering activity with my family and friends?

I Yes! Share the registration link with friends and family over the age of 12\*. You can also enjoy activities with younger family members, there are plenty of options for families.

#### Do I need to cover any volunteering related expenses?

I No. As a volunteer, you're entitled to reimbursement for any expenses incurred while volunteering. Covered costs include, for example, transport to the activity site. You'll need to provide a receipt, and the reimbursement will be handled through the platform provided by the association.

#### Do I need to participate in volunteering activities every week?

I Everyone has different availability. If you can volunteer often, that's great! But even if you only have time occasionally, your contribution is still valuable. Every bit helps!

#### How will I find out about nearby activities?

I When you register as a CaixaBank volunteer and agree to receive updates, we'll send you a regular newsletter with activities happening near you. And don't forget to follow us on social media to stay informed!

#### I want to join! How do I get my volunteer polo shirt?

Request it through this <u>link.</u> Choose your nearest CaixaBank branch and, in a few days, you'll be able to pick it up there.
